Bonfire collage

Tips on how to make your own arts and craft bonfire!

This is a super fun way to enjoy your bonfire night and it leaves a lovely reminder.

Option 1

You will need: Paper Sticks/twigs Leaves Glue Sellotape



How to make it:

- 1. Break your sticks/twigs into small pieces.
- 2. Using one stick/twig at a time sellotape it to the bottom of your paper.
- 3. Continue sellotaping sticks/twigs to your paper, occasionally crossing them over. Make them as messy as you want!
- 4. Once this is done, take your biggest leaf and glue the back of it.
- 5. Press the glue side of the leaf to the piece of paper to stick it down.
- 6. Continue to glue different size leaves to the paper.

(Top tip. If you don't want to glue the leaves you can sellotape them instead).

Option 2

You will need:

Coloured paper (orange/ yellow/ red/ brown)
White paper sheet
Scissors - ask for help when using these
Glue

How to make it:

- Cut your orange/ yellow/ red paper into flame-shaped pieces
- 2. Cut your brow paper into twig-shaped pieces
- 3. Glue the flames to a white paper sheet (shown in picture)
- 4. Glue the brown paper twigs to the bottom of the flames (shown in picture)





Option 3

You will need:
White paper
Colouring pencils
Scissors - ask for help when using these
Glue

How to make it:

- 1. Cut the white paper into flame-shaped and twig-shaped bits
- 2. Colour them in using any colour you'd like
- 3. Glue the flames to a white paper sheet
- 4. Glue the twigs at the bottom of the flames



If you're feeling creative, use any other materials or any other colours to make your bonfire collage!
