

diy birdfeeder

Make your own orange feeder and watch the birds ☒

Materials

orange
A long piece of twine, yarn or string
Any kind of bird seed

1. With the help of an adult, cut the orange in half and scoop out the insides.
2. Pierce 4 small holes on opposite sides, just below the top edge of each half .
3. Cut your twine into 2 pieces and thread one piece through a hole, and back out of one on the opposite side of the orange
4. Once both pieces of twine have been threaded through the holes, you should have an 'X' shape.
5. Gather the ends together and tie in a knot.
6. You can either do this with just one half of an orange, or make another with the other half.
7. Fill the centre of the orange with bird seed and venture outside to find a sturdy branch to hang it from
