
How do you make a flipbook?

- Get a thick stack of paper. You'll need a thick stack of small pieces of paper, so you can staple or glue them together or you can just bind your stack of paper with a paperclip, you can use as many sheets of paper as you need to tell your story.
- 2. The first sheet of paper in your stack will be the last image of your flipbook. Use a pencil to draw your image towards the bottom right of your paper stack so you can see it when you start to flip. if you draw the image too close to the staple, it won't be visible while flipping.



3. You have to start your story in reverse order, meaning the ending comes first and the beginning last. Make sure you draw the sequence in the same area as the previous one, but change its movement slightly. You can place a light beneath the stack of paper to see the initial image better, creating a tracing paper effect.



4. Repeat step 3. until you finish your stack of paper.



5. After finishing the animation sequence on your sheets of paper, you can enhance it with marker, ink or other colors. Then, flick through it quickly from front to back to see it come to life!
