## Paper Spinner

## What do you need?

- Twine
- Cardboard circle (you could use an old cereal box)
- Paper
- Pens or pencils
- Scissors (make sure to ask an adult for help)
- Glue stick



## How do you make a paper spinner?

1. Draw 2 circles onto your paper, you can use a template for this, something like a bowl works great.
2. Add colour to these circles, the more colourful, the more fun it is to see as it spins

3. Cut out the paper circles with scissors (ask an adult for help with this)
4. Cut out one circle from the cardboard, the same size as the paper circles.
5. Glue on the paper circles to the cardboard, one on each side!
6. Poke two holes right in the centre of the cardboard circle, you could use a toothpick or a pencil (you may need to ask an adult for help)
7. Take a piece of twine, or string, about 28 inches long, and tie the ends together so it makes a loop through the spinner
8. Take a piece of rope in each hand with the circle in the middle and spin the string so that it's twisted on both sides, then pull the string outwards to make it spin!
